AN ACT

1	Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled
2	"An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the
3	executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the
4	Executive Department thereof and the administrative
5	departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,
6	including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or
7	Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or
8	authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative
9	departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and
10	duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative
11	officers, and of the several administrative departments,
12	boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the
13	Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive
14	and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of
15	certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and
16	other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,
17	and commissions; providing for judicial administration; and
18	prescribing the manner in which the number and compensation
19	of the deputies and all other assistants and employes of
20	certain departments, boards and commissions shall be
21	determined, " in powers and duties of the Department of Drug
22	and Alcohol Programs, further providing for powers and
23	duties.
24	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
25	hereby enacts as follows:
26	Section 1. Section 2301-A(1)(xviii) of the act of April 9,
27	1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative Code of

1 1929, is amended to read:

2 Section 2301-A. Powers and duties.

3 The Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs shall have the 4 power and its duty shall be:

(1) To develop and adopt a State plan for the control,
prevention, intervention, treatment, rehabilitation,
research, education and training aspects of drug and alcohol
abuse and dependence problems. The State plan shall include,
but not be limited to, provisions for:

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11 (xviii) Providing standards for the approval by the 12 relevant State agency for all private and public 13 treatment and rehabilitative facilities, which may 14 include, but are not limited to, State hospitals and 15 institutions, public and private general hospitals, 16 community mental health centers or their contracting 17 agencies and public and private drug or alcohol 18 dependence and drug and alcohol abuse and dependence 19 treatment and rehabilitation centers. The standards 20 shall prohibit private and public treatment and 21 rehabilitation facilities from denying addiction 22 treatment to an individual solely due to a negative 23 result on a drug test. * * * 24

25 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.

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
