| 16          | (c) DefinitionsAs used in this section, the following  |
| 17          | words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this  |
| 18          | subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:   |

- 1 <u>"Sky lantern." An unmanned and self-contained luminary</u>
- 2 <u>device that uses heated air produced by an open flame or another</u>
- 3 <u>source to become or remain airborne.</u>
- 4 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
